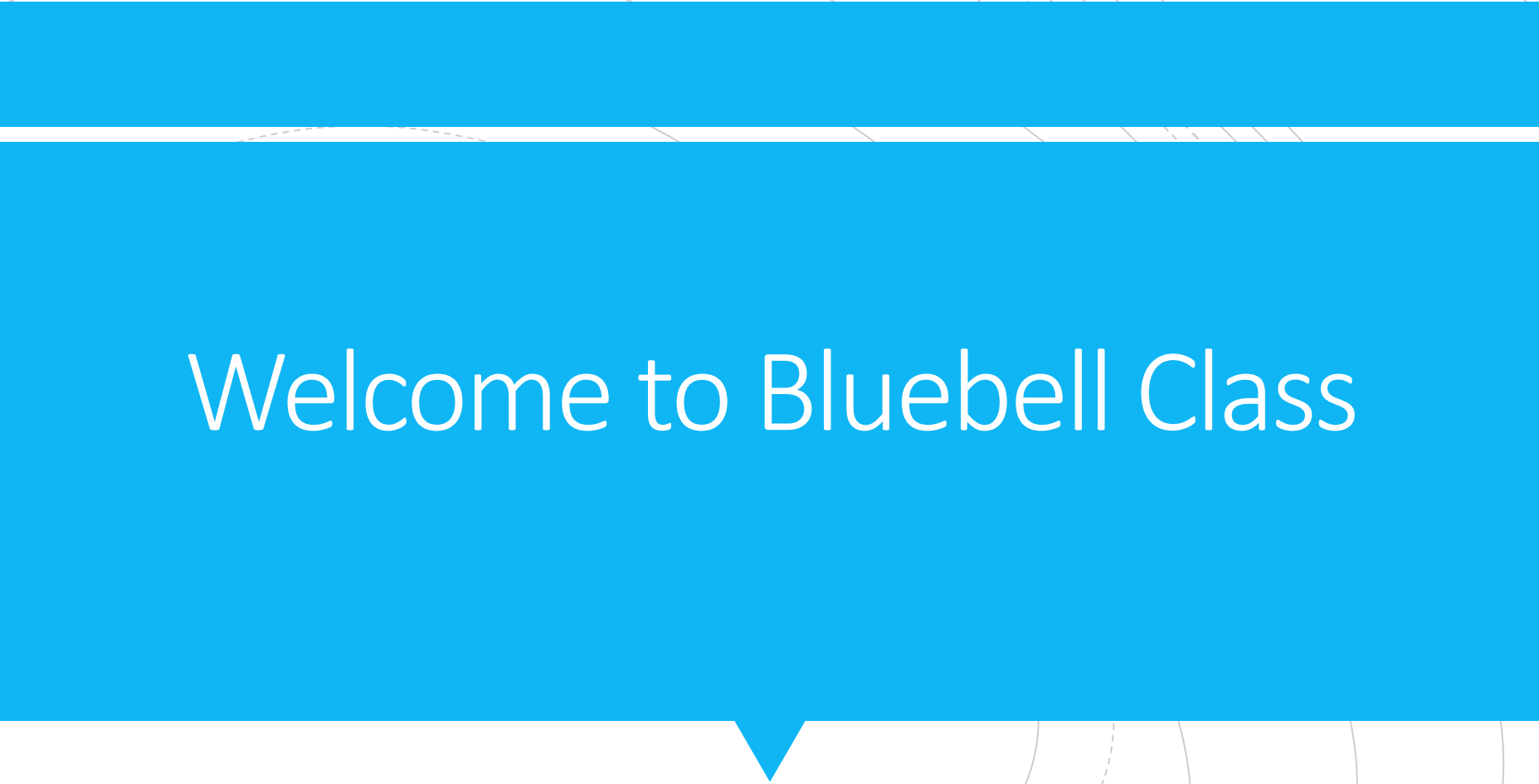

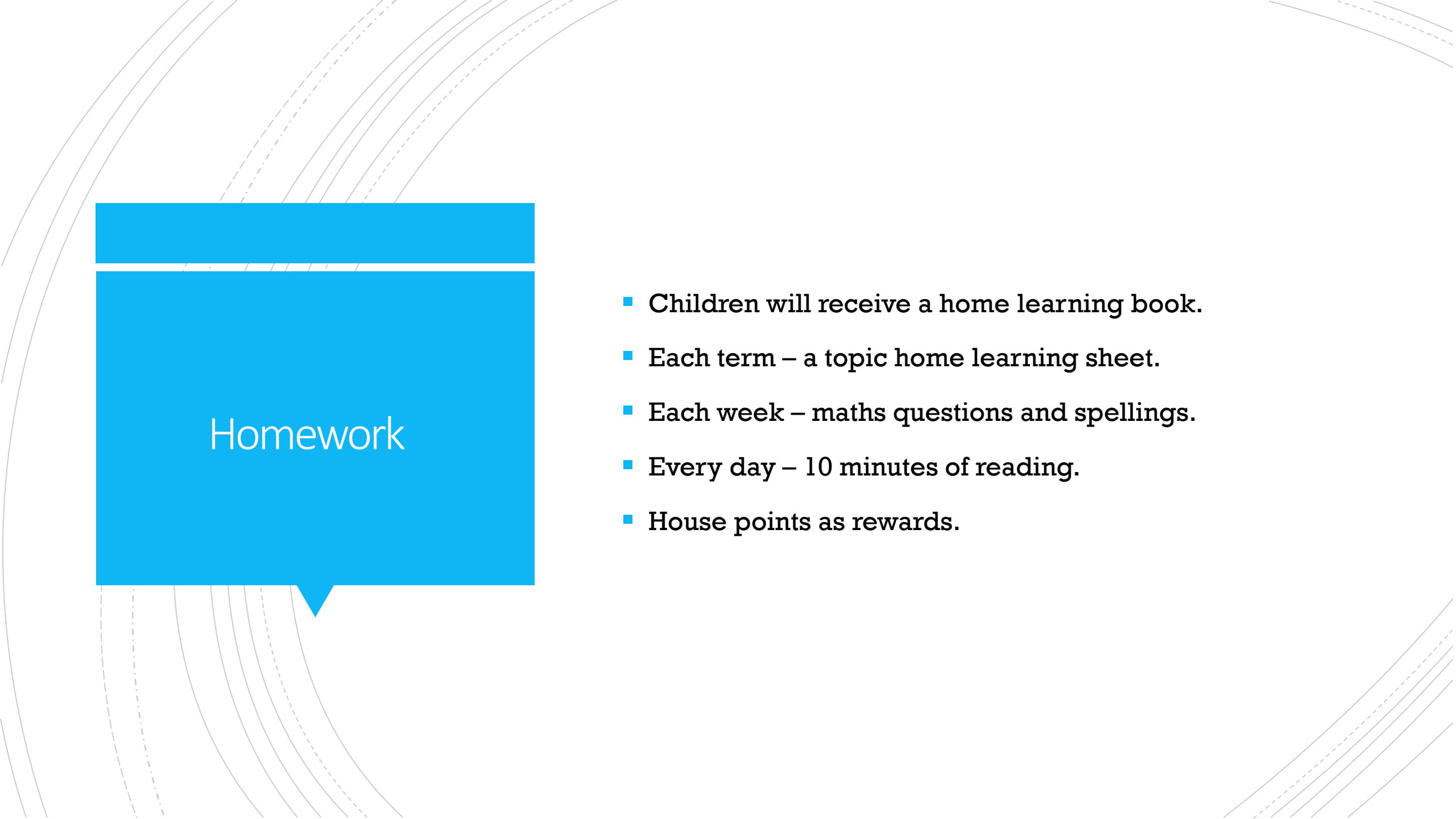

Behaviour for learning

Reading

- We follow the Little Wandle scheme
- Books are changed twice a week
 - Monday and Thursday for Courage and Resilience
 - Tuesday and Friday for Kindness and Honesty
- Children receive 1:1 reading books as well as a sharing book which is to be read with an adult
- Please try to read with your children as regularly as possible, ideally 10 minutes a day, and record this in their reading journal

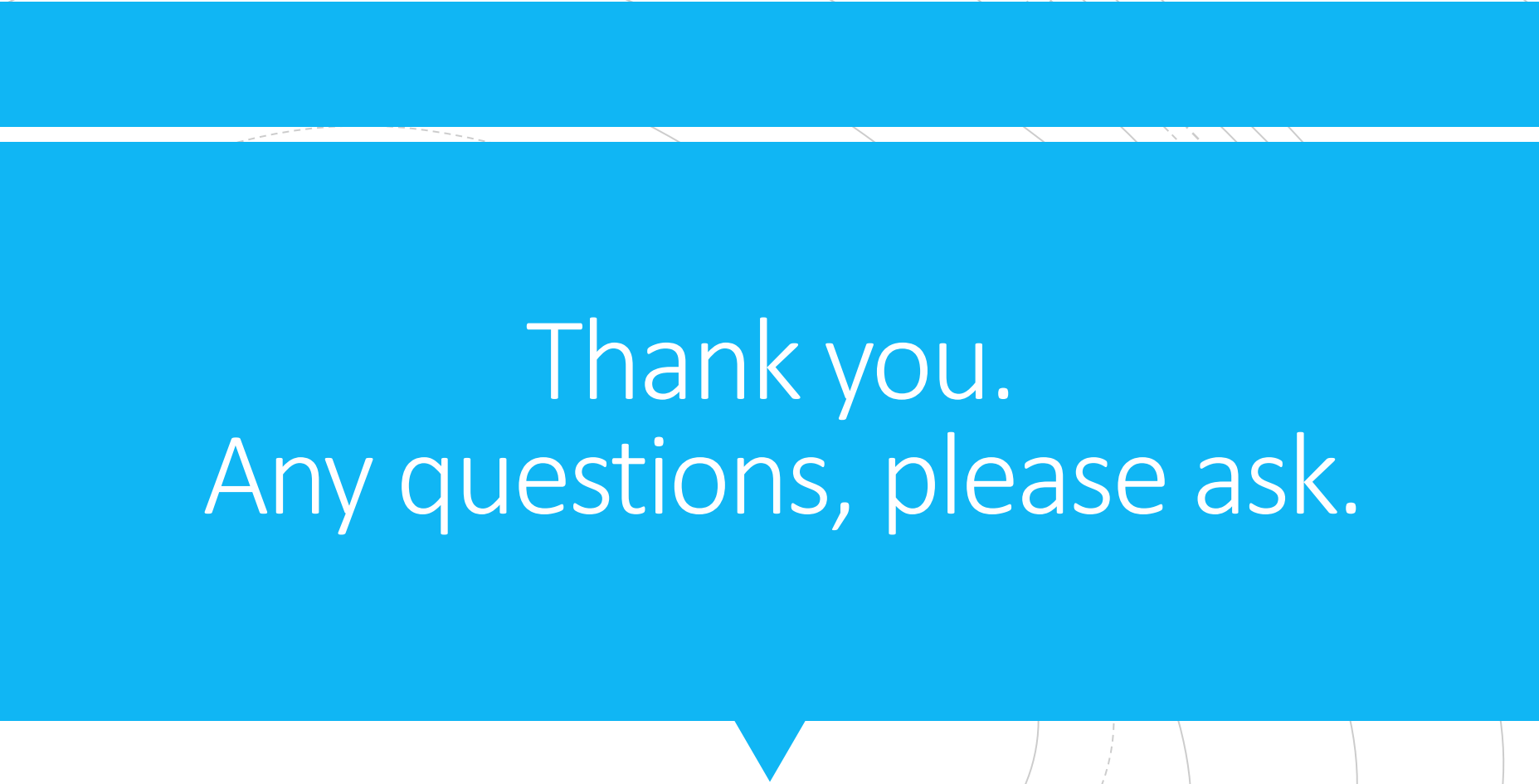

Homework

- Children will receive a home learning book.
- Each term – a topic home learning sheet.
- Each week – maths questions and spellings.
- Every day – 10 minutes of reading.
- House points as rewards.

Assessments

- Maths
 - 1-2 weeks after each unit.
- English
 - Hot and cold tasks.
- Phonics/reading
 - At the end of each term.
- Phonics screening assessment
 - In June, children will take part in a statutory Phonics test. Children will be shown a number of real and nonsense words to read aloud in order to test their knowledge of the phonics sounds. Should a child not pass, they will then retake the test in the following June when in Year 2.
