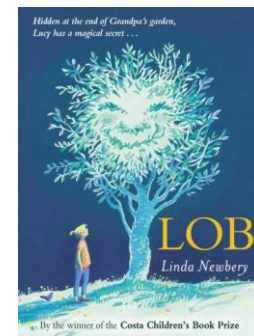
English
