Vocabulary	Definition
Autumn	Autumn is one of the four seasons of the year and is the time of year that transitions Summer to Winter. Along with the tree leaves changing colour, the temperature grows colder, plants stop making food, animals prepare for the long months ahead and the daylight starts growing shorter.
Bonfire	Guy Fawkes and his friends wanted to blow up important buildings in London where the King lived. He was caught and nobody was hurt. Bonfire night is a reminder that nobody got hurt as he got caught.
Harvest	In Britain, harvest is celebrated to give thanks for the crops that the farmers have worked hard to grow.
Nativity	This is the story of the birth of Jesus.
Poppies	It's become a symbol of hope, strength and resilience in the face of difficulties.
Remembrance Day	It is a reminder of the casualties in World War 1. The country stops at 11o'clock on the 11 th November for 2 minutes to remember.
Spring	Is a time of new plant growth. It is when animals become active again after the Winter.
Summer	The warmest season of the year, falling between spring and autumn.
Winter	Is the coldest season of the <u>year</u> .
